A. Eligibility criteria:

- 1. A bonafide Tibetan.
- 2. Member of a recognized JLG.
- 3. Endorsement from the JLG leader.

B. Selection priority:

- 1. Family headed by single parents or women.
- 2. Lack or no own capital.
- 3. Entrants or New comers.

C. Roles and Responsibility of SOs:

- 1. Issuing bona fide certificate.
- 2. TRLSP's legal documents verification.
 - a) Support fund application form
 - b) Bond between SO/SARD and the borrower
 - c) Promissory note
 - d) Sales deed of the Horses/Mules purchased
- 3. Submission of documents to SARD on time.
- 4. Safeguarding "One Household, One Support" principle.
- 5. Real time communication & coordination with SARD.
- 6. Ensuring smooth repayment and to conduct M&E activities.

D. Roles and Responsibility of Tibetan Caravan Group Leader:

- 1. Formulation of and execution of the rules.
- 2. Select bona fide beneficiaries based on the clause (B).
- 3. Maintaining good relation amongst members
- 4. Maintenance of on time communication & coordination with SARD.
- 5. Reporting of the progress and the gaps to SOs.
